



Daisy (*Bellis perennis*) - a plant species of the Asteraceae family. It occurs in much of Europe, Western Asia and Azerbaijan, and Libya. Spreads are also some places outside the area of the home. It is common throughout the Polish. It grows in meadows, pastures, roadsides. It is grown as an ornamental plant, mainly because of the spectacular flowers. Cultivars have white or full color shades of red color, often have larger inflorescences with more flowers. It is used also in the pharmaceutical industry.
